

## 2022 RV Rules and Policies

- Trailers are to be placed on grounds on **Sunday, July 17, from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm** unless other arrangements have been made with Fair Staff.
- Trailer parking pass (1 per site) must be placed in the window of your vehicle and visible at all times for admittance to the fairgrounds. Camping fees do not include admission to the fair. Admission passes can be purchased at the Fair Office.
- **Quiet Hours:** 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM each night.
- **No dogs are allowed on the fairgrounds!** This applies to all fair attendees. The only exception is if the dog is entered in a show, which is to be removed immediately following the conclusion of the show or service dogs that are properly identified.
- One responsible chaperone (parent or leader 25 years of age) is required per trailer. Siblings are not considered chaperones no matter the age. No Junior Exhibitor, even if 18 or older, can stay without a chaperone. If there is no chaperone after 10:00 pm thru 6:00 am, you will not be able to reserve a trailer space for the 2023 Fair.
- The adult leader or parent with trailer will be required to sign the application and this sheet acknowledging they have read these rules and agree to abide by them.
- RV's must be within the designated space line and not encroaching on their neighbor's space. A trailer with pop-outs may not fit and may be asked to pull in the pop-out if it is over the lines, inhibiting the neighbor from entering their trailer or causing an unsafe situation. Trailers should not be touching each other.
- All vehicles must be moved to a designated parking area prior to 8:00 am.
- Horse trailers must be parked behind barn 5 and cannot be parked in camping areas or livestock areas.
- **Alcohol Policy:** The following are the procedures that the Lassen County Fair will follow to minimize any alcohol-related problems:
  - No six packs, bottles or cans of any kind will be allowed on the grounds outside of RV space.
  - No drinking in the parking lots or beyond your RV space.
  - No Adult exhibitor will be allowed to consume alcohol while on duty or in their exhibit area.
  - **ZERO tolerance of minors and alcohol.** Minors exhibiting at the fair will have their exhibit removed from any competition and sale, and will be stripped of all awards.
  - All outside food and beverage brought into camping area with trailer must stay in camping area.
- **No firearms or weapons** are permitted on the fairgrounds. Fair management reserves the right to determine what is considered a weapon.
- Violation of rules or fair policies is grounds for loss of trailer spaces.
- Minor violations of the rules will result in the following consequences:
  - Verbal warning
  - Written citation
  - Removal of trailer from fairgrounds
- Serious violations of above rules (i.e.-use of alcohol or drugs or possession and/or use of firearms or other weapons) will result in immediate ejection from the fairgrounds, loss of privilege to sell in the Jr. Livestock Auction, entries removed from fairgrounds, and loss of premiums.
- No unauthorized ATVs/UTVs at camp spots or on grounds at any time.
- **NO REFUNDS FOR SPACE RENTALS!**
