Adult Fine Art Amateur

All art work & photography must be framed & ready to hang on peg board with screw eyes or D-rings & wire.

Work must have been done within a 12 month period.

All art must be framed & ready to hang with wires. No alligator clips or adhesive hangers. All prints & drawings must be mounted on hard-backed surface with name & address of exhibitor & title of exhibit on reverse side.

BEGINNER ADULT: A beginning art student.

INTERMEDIATE ADULT: An exhibitor who has two or more year's art experience.

ADVANCED ADULT: An exhibitor who has four or five year's art experience.

PROFESSIONAL ADULT: An exhibitor who engages in an event or activity as a profession, including those who teach, design, or any person who is paid for their work.

Any exhibits in this Division must have been produced within the last 12 months by the exhibitor. All prints & drawings are to be mounted on hard-backed surface with the name & address of the exhibitor & title or print on reverse side. A suitable hanger must be attached. Every picture, drawing, etc., must be on poster board with stapled string hanger or professional hanging materials attached & ready to hang. **DO NOT USE TAPE AS IT WILL NOT HOLD.** All junior fine arts need to be framed or matted. Junior Organization Exhibitors enrolled in projects where Organization Division is offered (4-H & FFA) are not eligible to enter the Open Junior Department. If a Division is not offered for an organizational project, the Junior Organizational Exhibitor may enter in the Open Junior Department. No cross entries are allowed.
