American system of judging

RULES:

1. Exhibits in the Floriculture Department must have been grown by the exhibitor within the county, district or community represented by the exhibitor, except classes for arrangements.
2. Exhibits must be adequately & correctly labeled. Exhibitors to designate variety, if at all possible.
3. All containers will be furnished by the Fair for cut flowers. The exhibitor will furnish his or her own container in any arrangement divisions. The management will not be held responsible for any lost or damaged containers & accessories.
4. Exhibitors should freshen displays & cut flowers as often as necessary to keep them looking their best. Management reserves the right to dispose of cut flowers that wilt & are not replaced by the exhibitor.
5. All flowers must have their own foliage, except in the arrangement divisions.
6. A bouquet is made up of 7 or more flowers & foliage.
7. Plant material used in dry arrangements must be all natural. Bows & other accessories may be used, but must only be to accent the piece.
8. Drip Pans are required on ALL plants needing watering.
 - **BEGINNER:** An exhibitor who has NEVER won a blue ribbon in the Floriculture Department at any Fair, or best of show.
 - **INTERMEDIATE:** An exhibitor who has won under 20 blue ribbons.
 - **ADVANCED:** An exhibitor who has won more than 20 blue ribbons.
 - **PROFESSIONAL:** An exhibitor who engages in an event or activity as a profession, including those who teach, design, or any person who is paid for their work.

DIVISION 390-Container House Plants

(No container with inside diameter greater than 20")

Class:

(Ex: Air Garden, Fair Gardens, Terrariums, etc.)

DIVISION 391-Container Plants, Annual or Perennial

(No container with inside diameter greater than 20")

Class:

1. Container Plants, Annual or Perennial, Specify
(Ex: Topiary, Hanging/Twining, Flowering Collection, etc.)

DIVISION 392-Perennial Container Plants with Ornamental Foliage

(No container with inside diameter greater than 20")

Class:

1. Perennial Container Plants with Ornamental Foliage, Specify
(Ex: Hosta, Polemonium, Fern, Pulmonaria, Grass, etc.)

DIVISION 393-Wheelbarrow Garden

Any size wheel barrow to be provided by exhibitor may be used. Please specify size on entry form.

May contain any kind of materials found in the Floriculture and Agriculture Departments. Examples include, but not limited to: silks, straw, veggies. Use your imagination! This is a great one for groups, classrooms, clubs, etc.

DIVISION 394-Fun Containers

DIVISION 399–Cut Flowers

(Three stems unless otherwise stated)

1. Cut Flowers, Specify
(Ex: Begonias, Antirrhinum, Convolvulus, Cosmos, etc.)

DIVISION 400-Asters

Class:

1. Asters, Specify

DIVISION 401–Petunias

(3 blossoms)

Class:

1. Petunias, Specify

DIVISION 402–Gladiolas

(1 stalk unless specified)

Class:

1. Gladiolas, Specify

DIVISION 403–Dahlias

Specimen bloom stem length to be proportional to the bloom, no leaf needed. Dahlias to be disbudded.

DIVISION 404– Unwin Dahlias

(3 Blooms)

Class:

1. Unwin Dahlias, Specify

DIVISION 405–Arboreal Cut Branches Tree or Shrubs

Class:

1. Arboreal Cut Branches Tree or Shrubs, Specify
2. (Ex: Dogwood Shrub, Japanese Maple, Nandina, etc.)

DIVISION 406–Flowers-Perennials

(Three stems unless otherwise stated)

Class:

1. Flowers Perennials, Specify
(Ex: Achilla, Babies Breath, Dusty Miller, etc.)

Roses

Outdoor grown roses shall be exhibited 1/2 to 3/4 open, including thorns & full foliage on stem above the water line. All specimens should be appropriately named, if known. Example: Rose, Red, Hybrid Tea, Mr. Lincoln

DIVISION 407–Roses

Please specify on entry form. Any color unless specified.

Class:

1. Roses, Specify
(Ex: Hybrid Tea, Peace, Rose Hybrid Tea Peace, etc.)

DIVISION 408–Zinnias

(Medium & small, 3 stems to a container. Large & giant, 1 stem to a container)

Class:

1. Zinnias, Specify

Floral Arranging & Design

Designer has a choice of materials fresh, dried or both in each design, real fruit, nuts and foliage allowed.

Any dry plant material may be treated with a preservative and colored by artificial means.

DIVISION 413-Creative Floral Design

Class:

1. Creative Floral Design
(Ex: Boot Scootin, Antique Shop, Holiday, Fiesta, etc.)

DIVISION 414–Fresh Floral Vase Arrangements

Must contain all fresh flowers and foliage. Vase to be provided by exhibitor.

Class:

1. Fresh Floral Vase Arrangements, Specify
(Ex: Making Memories, Garden Party, Fair Theme, etc.)

DIVISION 415-Fresh Floral Arrangement

Traditional

Class:

1. Coffee Table Arrangement
2. Garden Party
3. Exhibitor's Choice

DIVISION 416-Creative Floral Wall hanging

Design

(“a traditional or creative design of plant material(s) & other (optional) components attached or bonded to a background panel. Must have a hook adequate for hanging from a wall peg.”)

Class:

1. Creative Floral Wall Hanging Design, Specify
(Ex: Traditional, Three Dimensional, Abstract, etc.)

DIVISION 417-Miniatures

(Fresh floral arrangement, 3”x 3” or less)

Class:

1. Miniatures, Specify
(Ex: Garden Surprise, Tinkerbelle)

DIVISION 418–Petites

(Fresh floral arrangement, no greater than 3” wide x 6” tall)

Class:

1. Petites, Specify
(Ex: Candy Store, Fairy Princess, Fruit & Spice)

DIVISION 419-Dry Arrangements

(Plant material used in dry arrangements must be all natural. Preserved is fine.)

Class:

1. Dry Arrangements, Specify
2. (Ex: Bounty of the Forest, Roadside Treasure, Fair Theme)

DIVISION 420 –Silk Arrangements

Class:

1. Silk Arrangements, Specify
(Ex: Winter, Spring, Summer, Fall)

Table Settings

DIVISION 425–Table Settings- I

Must contain at least two place settings on a tablecloth provided by exhibitor. Exhibit must include a floral design, be it fresh or other. Container grown plant alone is not a floral design. Other accessories are optional.

Class:

1. Table Settings, Specify
(Ex: Rose Garden, Surf & Turf, Holiday USA, etc.)

DIVISION 426-Table Settings- II

A place setting for one on a 15'' deep x 30'' wide covered board provided by the exhibitor. Exhibit must include a floral design, be it fresh or dry. A container grown plant alone is not a floral design.

Class:

1. Table Settings, Specify
(Ex: Silver Anniversary, Childs Delight, Mother's Day, etc.)

DIVISION 427-Exhibitional Table

An artistic arrangement of table components, within an allotted space not to exceed 15'' deep x 30'' wide to provide a creative effect without consideration for functional placement. All components chosen must be suitable for use on a dining table.

Class:

1. Exhibitional Table, Specify
(Ex: Slumber Party, Evening Interlude, Summer, etc.)

DIVISION 428–Exhibitional Table Settings

An artistic arrangement of table components, within an allotted space not to exceed 15'' deep x 24'' wide x 30'' tall, to provide a creative effect without consideration for functional placement. All components chosen must be suitable for use on a dining table. Must include a floral design which is judged on the point scale.

Plant material must be all natural.

JUNIOR PETITE

Plant material must be all natural.

Petite Division (3''-6'')

JUNIOR DRY & SILK ARRANGEMENTS

Dry arrangements must contain only natural plant material. Silk arrangements must contain a combination of dry and silk.

Plant material must be all natural. Fresh may be used.
