The exhibitor has the option to show animals fitted or slick shorn. The animals should be groomed & fitted to be presentable & competitive in the show ring. Danish System of Judging. Grade groups: Purple and Red =Market Ready, White= Not Market Ready (will not sell) No Cash Awards, Ribbons Only. After weigh-in, animals will be divided into weight groups.
