

# POULTRY

Exhibitors must have carry cages for their entries. Cages will not be provided. Cages must have solid bottoms and be leak proof. No carriers will be available to bring the animals to the judging tables. Exhibitors are expected to be on hand during judging to bring their animals to the judging tables. Exhibit will not be judged if exhibitor misses his or her call to bring rabbits to the table. Only youth exhibitors may carry animals to the judging table. All small animals will be housed on grounds for the duration of the Fair, their release date will be Sunday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> at 5PM. Junior poultry must be checked in by a junior exhibitor, or entry will not be accepted.

Danish System of judging.

No cash awards. Ribbons only.

Broiler pen of 2. Weight 4lbs. to 6lbs. per animal. All entries under 10 weeks of age. Market ducks can weigh between 3lbs. and 8lbs. Market turkeys shall not be over 22 weeks of age and not under 14lbs. Market geese must be at a minimum of 12lbs. and not over 22 weeks. A numbered leg band must identify all poultry, this must match the entry form. All market poultry will be banded with leg bands at weigh-ins. There is no average daily gain requirement. All qualified meat pens will sell through the Junior Livestock Auction. All small market animals are live pickup. All poultry market pens will be required to present a bill of sale at check-in. Pens not having a bill of sale will not be allowed to sell. If you choose to breed and raise your own market animals, you must still have a breeding statement/bill of sale. Grade groups: Purple and Red = market ready, White = not market ready (will not sell). Primary members are not eligible to sell meat pen rabbits or poultry at the Lassen Junior Livestock Auction.
